US NUCLEAR WEAPONS POLICIES ARE DANGEROUS

The United States is the only country to have ever used nuclear weapons against an adversary. In 1945, we turned Hiroshima and Nagasaki to rubble, killing tens of thousands of civilians in literal seconds. Since then, the United States—and eight other countries—have developed far more powerful nuclear bombs, capable of vastly more damage.

You might think that US nuclear weapons policies would reflect a commitment to never again unleash such devastation unless we were attacked with such weapons first. You'd be wrong. Current US policy dictates that our country can use nuclear weapons first in a non-nuclear conflict with Russia, China, or North Korea—each of which is nuclear-armed.

This policy allows the United States to initiate a nuclear war, with potentially disastrous consequences for the entire world. It also increases the likelihood that other nuclear states will use these weapons against us.

NO FIRST USE

UCS is starting with a simple and commonsense principle: The United States must commit to never initiate a nuclear conflict. A No First Use policy:

- Reduces the risk that another country will use nuclear weapons against the United States, either preemptively or in retaliation.
- Contributes to global stability, by reaffirming our leadership in arms control and risk reduction efforts, and inspiring other countries to take similar steps.
- Makes it less likely that nuclear weapons will ever be used.
